WHEREAS, three (3) sealed bidders submitted proposals; and

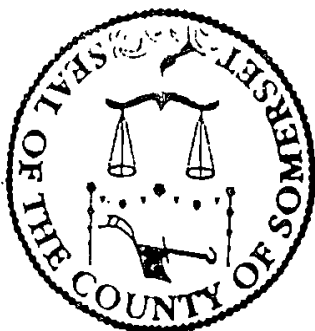
WHEREAS, the lowest bid price substantially exceeds the contracting unit's appropriation for this project; and
