WWI ended in 1918, but it took America a little longer make it official with the Knox-Porter Resolution. This important document was signed on July 2, 1921 – not in Washington – but in Somerset County, New Jersey. Why? Because the President was playing golf here.

★ Signed by the Burger King... not BY the Burger King, but next to it! A small plaque marks the former location of the Frelinghuysen home on Route 28 in Raritan where President Harding signed the Knox-Porter Resolution.
