- ★ In the late 19th and early 20th centuries most of Somerset County was farmland, and the one room school house was the most common type of school in the New Jersey countryside.
- There were no buses, and each school served students living up to 5 miles away – this was considered close enough to walk!
- **★** The school houses were only heated with a wood burning stove, so when kids walked to school in colder months, they carried books AND firewood.
