- ★ Completed in 1909, the Beaux Arts style Historic Courthouse was the site of the infamous Hall-Mills murder trial.
- ★ John Russell Pope designed the Lord Memorial Fountain at Grove and Main Streets AND the Jefferson Memorial in Washington, DC.
- ★ **Try this!** Find the two Meridian Markers on the Courthouse Green. Place a compass on top of the larger marker. Find north by aligning the compass with the smaller marker. The needle indicates magnetic north, the N, true north!
