



The Future Wastewater Service Areas shown on this map are based on the Future Wastewater Service Area Map for Somerset County adopted by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) on January 24, 2013 and March 5, 2013. They include site-specific amendments that have been adopted by the NJDEP since that time in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4, 3.5 and 4.4, as well as the consolidation/transfer of assigned sewer service areas implemented pursuant to the adoption of the Montgomery Township-Rocky Hill Borough Component of the Somerset County Wastewater Management Plan on November 4, 2019. Adoption of the Future Wastewater Service Areas shown on this map will memorialize transfers initiated by the Township of Warren and the Borough of Watchung. Upon adoption by the NJDEP, this map will supersede the Future Wastewater Service Areas Map for Somerset County adopted in 2013 and Map 3.2 - Future Wastewater Service Areas included in the Montgomery Township and Rocky Hill WMP Component.

All sewer service areas associated with NJPDES-regulated Discharge to Surface Water (DSW) or Discharge to Groundwater (DGW) wastewater treatment facilities (WWTFs) are designated as "Assigned Sewer Service Area". All lands not within an "Assigned Sewer Service Area" are included in the general wastewater service area for facilities with planning flows of 2,000 gallons per day (GPD) or less that discharge to groundwater designated as "Non-Sewer Service Area" represented by the white areas on the map. There are no "Unassigned Sewer Service Areas" as defined at N.J.A.C. 7:15-1.5 located in Somerset County.

The locations of WWTFs and associated discharge outfalls/points are approximate.

Somerset County and its municipalities request to be notified regarding any proposed changes to assigned sewer service areas that would transfer wastewater flows to a different wastewater treatment facility than which is currently identified. Furthermore, Somerset County recommends that a WQMP amendment or revision be pursued for proposed transfers of wastewater flows to other than the identified treatment facility following the procedures specified at N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.3 - 3.5, although contrary to N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.2(b).
