

The Knox-Porter Resolution Centennial

The Knox Porter Resolution officially ended America's involvement in WWI.

This important document was signed right here in Somerset County on July 2, 1921 at then-senator Joseph Frelinghuysen's home in Raritan. Sadly, the house burned down in the 1950s, but its former stone gates mark the location of this important American—and Somerset County—event.
