Leaning on the words of Mrs. Coretta Scott King, your Hope and Healing Team of Somerset County is breaking the barriers of isolation and taking action in the community to ease the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic.

As we continue to navigate through these unprecedented times, cities are reopening, a new school year has begun and returned to in-person learning, and vaccination numbers are rising. We know that folks are still plagued with so many decisions regarding their safety, though long to feel free again.

In the ongoing mission to assist the community in managing the emotional impact of the COVID - 19 pandemic, Somerset County Hope and Healing has found itself in a unique space, particularly in September. Wednesday evening, September 1st, New Jersey endured the remnants of Hurricane Ida, cooked in the Gulf of Mexico, hitting land that Monday in Louisiana. She maintained her strength heading east across the United States, finishing off in New Jersey and New York, and faded into the Atlantic, causing a heavy flash flood in the streets and homes of Somerset County residences.

This catastrophic event has created a compounding disaster experience for displaced individuals and families due to damages that have deemed their homes inhabitable. The Hope and Healing Team switched gears for a moment to tend to residents who have been moved to temporary housing, providing supportive counseling, tools, and resources to assist in their sudden transition. The team continues to explore opportunities to serve those tragically affected by Hurricane Ida as they approach an eventful last two weeks of the month.
