\$4.8M Allocated to Local **Support-Net Nonprofits**

The Board of County Commissioners allocated almost \$4.8 million in funding to non-profits and other community safety-net organizations as part of its bi-annual Non-Profit After two years of online activities, the centers are thrilled to welcome back in-person activities. The Board of County Commissioners meets twice-monthly, generally on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday. Meetings can be viewed live on the county website or Facebook page.


