# **PUBLIC COMMENT & PRESENTATIONS:**

# 1. Bridge Replacement E1002 – Bedminster/Bridgewater Townships

Principal Planner Kate Katzer updated the Board on the Section 19 process through the State Agriculture Development Committee (SADC) which reviews any projects occurring within an Agriculture Development Area (ADA) to ensure there are minimal impacts to that ADA and preserved farms. Staff most recently met with SADC to submit final documentation from Somerset County Engineering Department (Bridge Division) Ms. Katzer read the Resolution that is to be submitted to the SADC for final review and approval to the Board. Staff did meet with the landowner to ensure there were no impacts on the preserved farm, and to answer any questions the owner may have about the process. Kenneth Osterman made a motion to approve the resolution for Bridge Replacement E1002 in Bedminster/Bridgewater as read; the motion was seconded by Sandra Rhue.

Note: Vice Chairman Peter Staats did not take any action or participate in any discussion on this agenda item.

# 2. Drenchko and Sullivan Farms Update - Hillsborough Township

Debbie Norz, Hillsborough Township resident, asked for an update on progress for both Drenchko and Sullivan Properties. Office of Planning, Policy and Economic Development Director Walter Lane reported that the County has had ongoing discussions on both projects with the SADC and Hillsborough Township. The County has raised their concerns about encumbering the entire property to the SADC regarding the Sullivan Farm. As part of the newly adopted Open Space Preservation Plan, the County reenforced their vision to create a cross-county connection trail; and for both the Farmland and Open Space Preservation Programs to work in a collaborative manner.

#### **INFORMATIONAL ITEMS:**

#### SADC Meeting –Update

Dave Clapp, of the State Agriculture Development Committee (SADC) reported that the SADC will not hold its August meeting. The next meeting will be on September 22, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. at the State Offices in Trenton. Mr. Clapp reported that the SADC has convened a Farmland Preservation Policy subcommittee to examine

factors that are affecting land protection efforts, how they have changed over the years and possible changes for the future. A partner survey has gone out to various stakeholders and should be completed by September 9, 2022. Dave Clapp provided an update on the draft rule proposal for Soil Protection Standards and stated the rule proposal is being reviewed by the Office of the Attorney General (Governors Authority Unit) after which it will come back to the SADC for action.

Dave Clapp mentioned that SADC Legal Specialist, Allison Reynolds, resigned and her position as SADC Attorney with a background in Farmland Preservation is being posted to be filled.

Principal Planner Kate Katzer recapped this year's 4-H Fair event. The 4H Fair took place August 10<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and was a successful event. The 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Somerset County's first Preserved Farm, The Baron Farm will soon take place during 2023. Staff has been working to come up with several activities to celebrate the Anniversary. There are various kid friendly activities being put together for the next Ag Day by intern, Larisa Paxton. The focus is on the History of Somerset for this year's Ag Day.

Chairman Kirby expressed his delight in the success of this year's 4H Fair.
