Today, Somerset County is the home to the US Equestrian Team Olympic Training Center and Headquarters located in Gladstone, NJ. To this day the County's equestrian history is ever present, the equestrian team utilizes a barn built in 1916 – recognized as one of the largest and most lavish stables in the United States.
