









Corn Mazes are now a fun fall tradition, but have you ever wondered where the idea came from? Mazes have been a popular form of artwork for centuries. Formal gardens became popular in Europe-where the wealthiest castles and palaces had mazes to entertain royalty. The first corn maze was attributed to Annville, Pennsylvania.







In 1919, the first **Somerset** County 4-H Dairy Show was held on the Somerset County Courthouse Lawn, right after the Spanish Flu pandemic. Just a little over a 100 years later, the cows came back to the Courthouse Lawn to celebrate the history of agriculture in Somerset County-on the heels of another pandemic. Many of the roads in Hillsborough Township are named after the original charter members of our local New Centre Dairy 4-H Club that began in 1930.
