NOTICE OF PENDING BOND ORDINANCE

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, on July 11, 2023. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held at the County Administration Building, 20 Grove Street, Somerville, New Jersey on July 25, 2023 at 6:00 o'clock PM. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: Bond Ordinance Providing An Appropriation Of \$20,110,450 For Various Improvements And Purposes For And By The County Of Somerset, New Jersey, And Authorizing The Issuance Of \$19,104,928 Bonds Or Notes Of Somerset County For Financing Part Of The Cost Thereof

Various improvements to Raritan Valley Community College; Acquisition of Various Equipment and vehicles for the Somerset County Parks Commission, including but not limited to mowers, utility vehicles, bunker and field rake, hook truck, dump truck and chipper; Acquisition of various equipment for the Sheriff's Department, including but not limited to ballistic vests and data card system; Acquisition of various equipment and vehicles for the Prosecutor's Office, including but not limited to crime scene truck, technology equipment and furniture; Acquisition of various equipment and vehicles for the Recycling Department, including but not limited to curbside recycling trucks, recycling containers, rear loader garbage truck and fuel dispenser; Acquisition of 5-7 seat accessible buses (electric) and public transit buses (light duty), tablet hardware and mounting installation, camera/GPS systems and installation and electric charging stations for the Division of Transportation; Acquisition of Information Technology equipment, including but not limited to licensing, switches, servers, computers, printers, scanners, telephones, video equipment and office cubicles; Acquisition of Various Vehicles and Equipment, including but not limited to dump truck with spreader and plow and hook lift, crew mason dump truck with spreader and plow, dump trucks with plow, traffic signal control boxes, hook lift dump trucks with spreader and plow and F450 dump truck; Various Building Improvements, including but not limited to office reconfiguration at administration building, security improvements and court requested projects; Highway Reconstruction Class "A" -River Road (Hillsborough Township); Construction and Inspection, Drainage Structures, Milling, Curb, Bituminous Concrete Pavement, Traffic Stripes; Installation of Traffic Safety Improvements, including replacement of horizontal curve warning sign; Highway drainage and flood control – including but not limited to outfall mapping/inspection; Bridge Improvements - Fowler Road (Bridge No. D1206), Borough of Fair Hills, Rippling Brook Way (Bridge No. F1306), Borough of Bernardsville, Grove Street (Bridge No. MO906), Borough of Somerville, Lamington Road (Bridge No. C1102), Township of Bedminster, Burnt Mills Road (Bridge No. D1003), Township of Branchburg; Elm Street (Bridge No. CO601), Township of Branchburg; Wertsville Zion Road (Bridge No. BO301), Township of Montgomery; Stirling Road, (Bridge No. L1014), Township of Warren. Rehabilitation and reconstruction of bridges in various municipalities, various locations for construction and inspection repairs, various bridges on county or municipal roads throughout the County; acquisitions of easements, right-of-ways, land, or any rights in land, and property appraisals at various locations throughout the County; Various Building Improvements, including but not limited to various improvements at administration building, chiller replacement at 40 North Bridge Street, lighting replacement at Bernie Field parking deck, replacement of boiler at New Court House (design), fire alarm upgrades at Richard Hill Mental Health Center, and vehicle maintenance and South County fuel tank decommissioning and reinstallation (design); Various design, inspection, engineering work for various federally funded projects for various municipalities; and Various design, inspection, engineering work for various projects.
