This program will provide our citizens with a personalized photo ID, complete with Doctor's names and phone numbers, current medications and people to contact if needed. In addition, when put on a thumb drive or downloaded into the App, expanded information is available such as digital fingerprints, a larger list of medications and illnesses, likely making treatment faster and easier.



The SCSO V.I.P. uses cutting edge technology to provide an amazing service to our greatest resources - our youth. Young citizens will get a photo ID card that includes physical information as well as two fingerprints. When downloaded to a thumb drive or into the accompanying app, the expanded information includes all fingerprints, more photos, and additional information. This can be shared with anyone the user chooses preventively, or in an emergency, including law enforcement.



The Sheriff's Office has already made this international service available, which provides security and peace of mind for those who need it, as well as their caregivers. The addition of this service enhances the program so that participants will have a photo ID with emergency information on it, and the ability to keep the expanded information on a thumb drive or in the app. It gives the caretaker the ability to share with emergency services or law enforcement if necessary.
