KNOW & TELL is a training program for adults on preventing, recognizing, and reporting child abuse. Expert trainers provide interactive and dynamic workshops across New Jersey on how to create a safe community where all adults help promote child safety and understand their role as a mandated reporter of child abuse. - Red flags of child abuse
