## 1. SADC Meeting –Update

Susan Payne has retired, and Chuck Roohr will be acting Executive Director in the interim. A subcommittee is being formed to conduct a search to fill Susan's position. The SADC has hired new individuals to their staff. August there will be an outreach for the Formula Value held by the consultant hired by the SADC – they will be coming to the SCADB's regular meeting. The Soil Protection Standard has yet to be published in the Register; but will be in the coming weeks.

## 2. County /State Boards of Agriculture - Update

Debbie Norz informed the Board that September 7, 2024, is Ag in Action event. The Tom Everett Scholarship picnic will be held afterwards.

#### 3. Staff Comments

Ag Night will be held at the Patriot's Stadium on July 25<sup>th</sup>. Chris Carnevale will be new President for Ag Society, and will be installed shortly.

Ms. Katzer informed the Board that the 4-H Fair will be held August 7<sup>th</sup> through the 9<sup>th</sup> this year. Farmer Matt Puskas will be doing a Dairy exhibit in the County tent talking about how "Cows are Great Recyclers". There will be a Geo Cashing event put on by the Somerset County GIS department.

# 3. Galdi Farm – Franklin Township

Mr. Galdi has come in for his final approval for the regrading around the newly built house. To be discussed during closed session.

# 4. Susan Payne Resolution of Appreciation

The Resolution was read aloud to the Board. A motion to approve the Resolution was made by Debbie Norz and seconded by Laura DePrado. A roll call vote was made, and the vote was passed.

## 5. Excessive Heat Advisory Guidance Document

The Farming Community has received the Excessive Heat Advisory Guidance Document. There has been an uptick in communication regarding Excessive Heat

safety protocol. NJ Health has distributed information from the Center for Disease Control.

#### 6. Crop Vandalism Document

There have been several vandalism issues on Farm Properties such as trespassers riding dirt bikes and harming crops. Farmers have been inquiring about their rights in resolving these matters. The Farm Bureau has distributed publications regarding rules and allowances on top of regulations.

#### 7. Closed Session
