





The Borough's LOSAP provided for a base annual contribution by the Borough in the amount of \$600.00, supplemented by an additional yearly contribution in the amount of \$300.00 based on prior years of service, for each eligible member of the volunteer Peapack and Gladstone Fire Department and the Peapack-Gladstone First Aid and Rescue Squad to be deposited into a tax-deferred income account. The additional contributions based on prior years of service expired in 2010. With the expiration of contributions for prior years of service, the Borough of Peapack and Gladstone has decided that an increase in the amount of the Borough's annual base contribution on behalf of eligible participants in LOSAP from \$600.00 to \$1,000.00 is reasonable in order to ensure retention of existing active members and to provide incentives for recruiting new volunteer firefighters and first-aid organization members.

The cost will be included annually in the budget of the Borough of Peapack and Gladstone and is anticipated to be a maximum amount of \$40,000.00 per year.
