Somerset County Ranked 5th Best in U.S.

Somerset County, NJ, has been ranked the fifth-best county in the nation by online real estate brokerage firm Movoto.com.

In Movoto.com's real estate blog, Somerset is listed after only Loudoun County, VA, Douglas County, CO, Fairfax, VA and Chester County, PA. Morris County, NJ, is number six on the list.

The ranking encompasses 640 counties for which Movoto.com analyzed certain demographic information – unemployment rate, median household income, median rent, median home price, high school graduation rate and percent of families below the poverty line – using the 2010 Census.
