# BOROUGH OF WATCHUNG LOCAL QUESTION

If this question is approved by the voters, the Borough will amend the language in its current regulation mandating an annual levy of \$0.02 per one hundred (\$100) dollars of assessed valuation to allow the Governing Body the flexbility of collecting an amount from zero (\$0.00) cents up to and not to exceed \$0.02 cents per one hundred (\$100) dollars of assessed valuation. What this means is that a house assessed at one hundred thousand (\$100,000) dollars will pay a maximum of \$20 per year while a house assessed at two hundred thousand (\$200,000) dollars will pay a maximum of \$40 per year in additional property taxes, however, action taken by the Mayor and Council may implement collection of a lesser amount as determined by need. This money will be deposited into a "Municipal Open Space Trust Fund" and shall be used exclusively for the following purposes as determined by the Mayor and Council: acquisition, development and maintenance of lands for recreation and conservation purposes; acquisition of farmland for farmland preservation purposes; historic preservation of historic properties, structures, facilities, sites, areas or objects and the acquisition of such properties, structures, facilities, sites, areas or objects for historic preservation purposes; or payment of debt service or indebtedness used or incurred by the Borough for any of the purposes set forth above.
