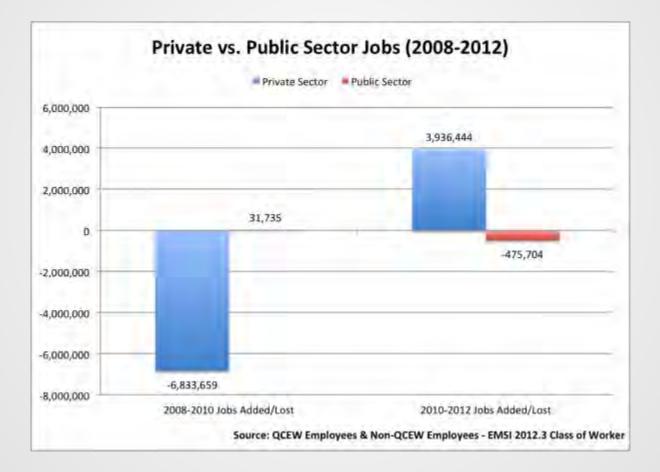

- The global economy has yet to shake off the fallout from the crisis of 2008-2009
- Uncertainty across the regions continue to have global impacts
- Continued fundamental social, economic & political shifts for US and other countries

- Growth of the world economy has weakened considerably during 2012
- This pace of growth will not be sufficient to overcome the continued jobs crisis
- Weaknesses in the major developed economies are at the root of the global economic slowdown

- Average job creation in the US was 151,000 a month in 2012
- Though the pace is less than robust, its steadiness is reassuring
- Corporations plan more layoffs as healthcare reform becomes a reality



Impact on Somerset County 2013

- New Jersey comes back from Sandy with record job gain
- Housing market has bottomed out and foreclosures have fallen to lowest levels
- County Clerk fees retained by the county were up over last year



Impact on Somerset County 2013

- Interest on County investments still lukewarm
- It is predicted that rates will remain low in the near term
- Inflation & real wages are stagnant
- Demand for human and social services remains steady

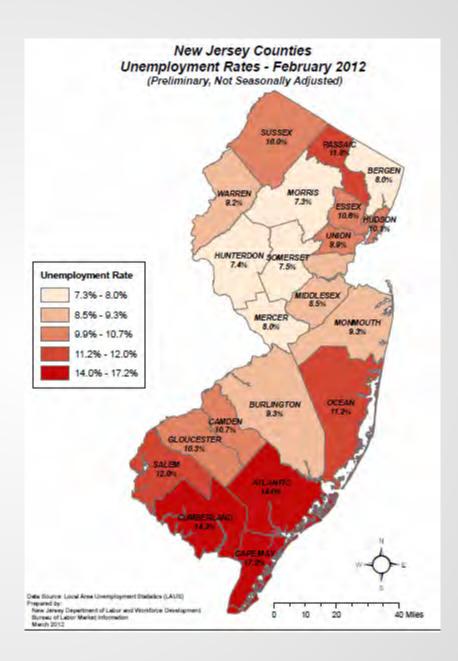
Impact on Somerset County 2012

Somerset County (Feb.) - 7.5%



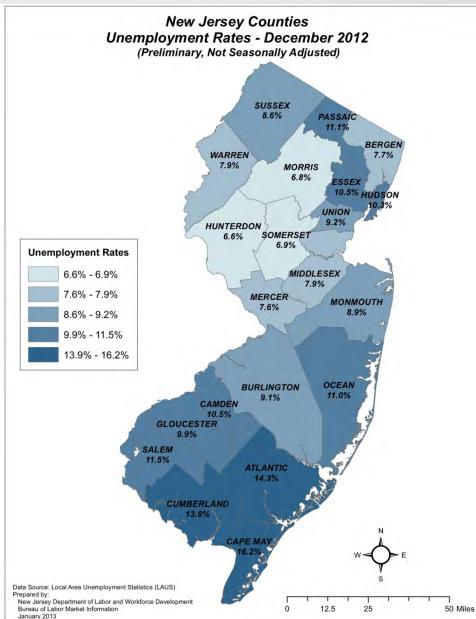


Unemployment Rates

Somerset County Responses What We've Done

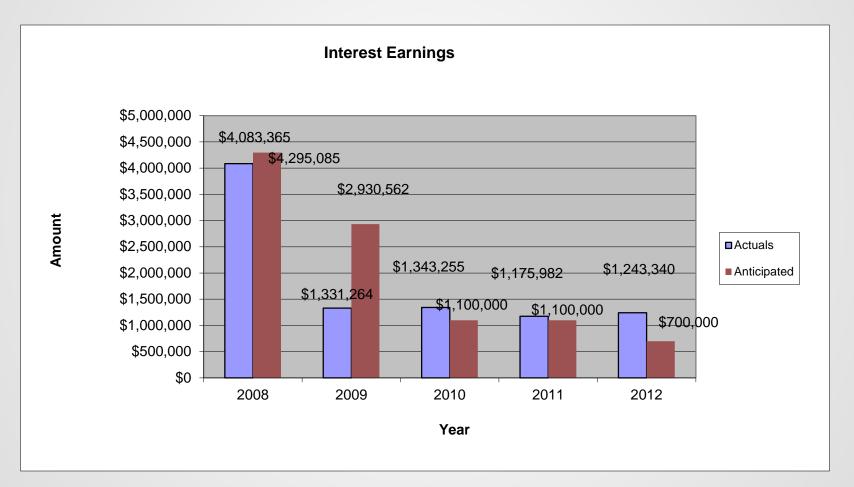
- Somerset County has planned for a extended recessionary & post-recessionary period

Somerset County Initiatives What We've Done

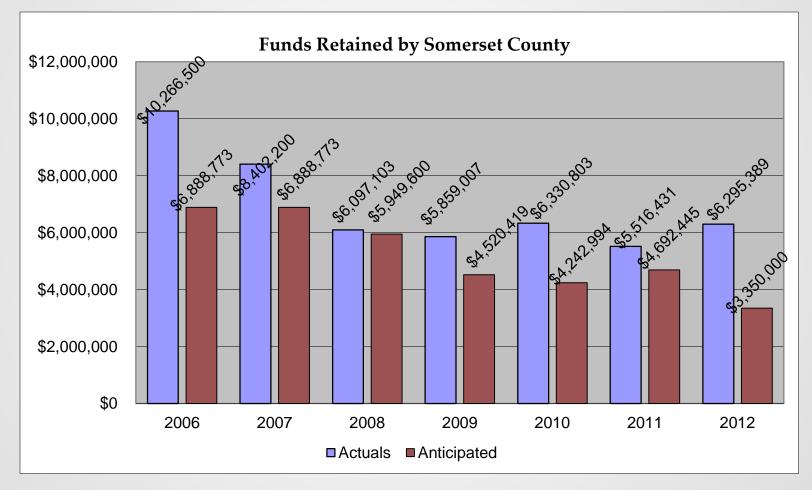
- Continuing takeover of 911 Dispatch and Health service coverage areas

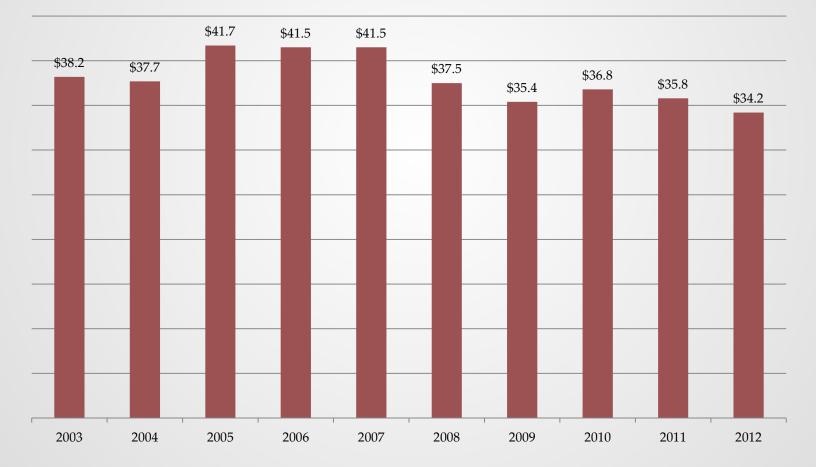
