SECTION I. The lane location(s) described are designated as Turn Reservation(s) and

traffic shall move as indicated:

Route 518 and Spring Hill Road

Eastbound left lane of Georgetown-Franklin
Turnpike reserved for "Left Turns Only"

SECTION II. Regulatory signs, conforming to the current manual on Uniform Traffic

Control Devices for Streets and Highways shall be erected and maintained

to effect the above – designated Left Turn Lane reservation(s).

SECTION III. This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as

required by law and upon certification by the Somerset County Engineer.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all previous ordinances or resolutions establishing a Left Turn reservation at the aforementioned intersection herein described are hereby repealed.
